Religious festivals calendar – a quick insight

St. Stephen's Feast Day

WHO? Christians

WHEN? December 26th annually

WHAT? The day commemorating St. Stephen's life and service as he became the first Christian to die for his faith in 34AD.

CUSTOMS & PRACTICES? Saint Stephen is the patron saint of bricklayers and

stonemasons. He was a deacon in the early Christian church and cared for the poor. Stephen was stoned to death by the Jewish council in Jerusalem after he condemned them for murdering the Messiah, Jesus Christ.



Why is the 26th December called Boxing Day in England? Boxing Day got its name when Queen Victoria was on the throne. In Victorian times, the wealthy would box up items they no longer needed to give to the poor. It was a day where servants would be given time off and thanked for their hard work with a 'special box' of treats. In Ireland, when the entire island was part of the United Kingdom, the Bank Holidays Act 1871 established the feast day of Saint Stephen as a non-moveable public holiday on 26 December. Following partition in 1920, Northern Ireland reverted to the British name, Boxing Day.
