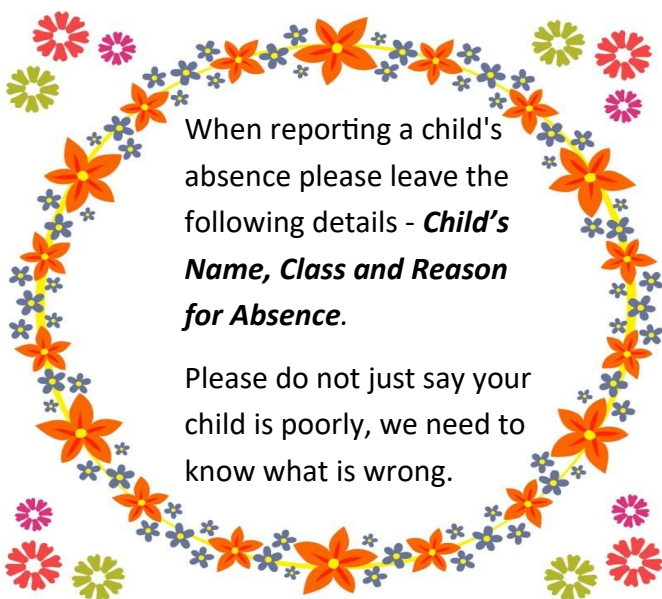

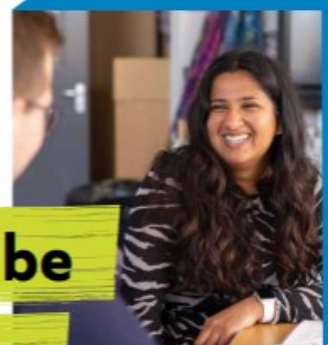

## Safer Internet Day 2025 – Too good to be true?

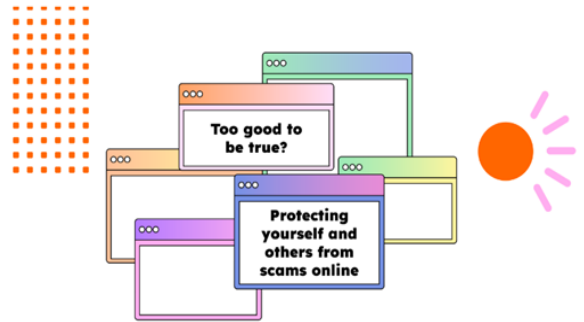
Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> February 2025

The children will take part in lessons linked to staying safe online and our focus in collective worship will be on staying safe online.

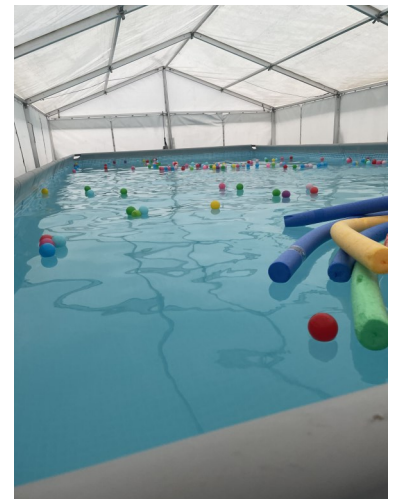

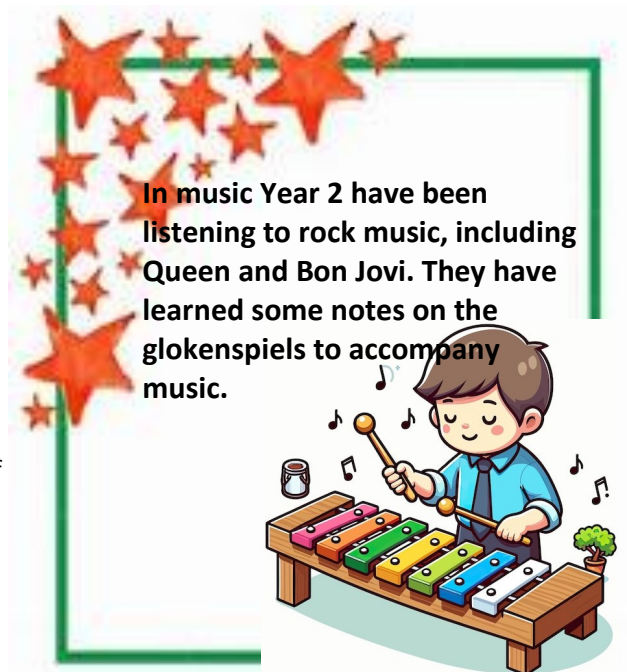
