

Operation Encompass is an initiative to share important information between the police and schools when then there has been a domestic incident. Police share information with Social Care and information is shared with school via email or phone call to let them know the name of the child/ren involved and the date of the incident. The Operation Encompass key adult will record all details and ensure that the child/ren is supported appropriately.
